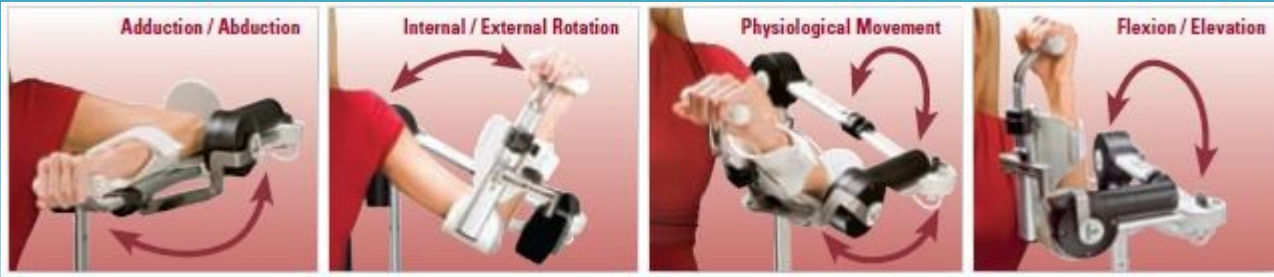

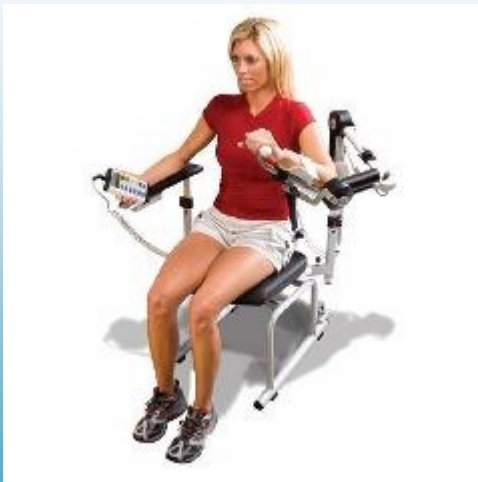

## Benefits of Use

- ◆ Fully synchronized motors allow treatment parameters to be customized.
- ◆ Speeds healing by allowing the joint to bend, however, does not pull on the incision site
- ◆ Helps prevent post-operative complications
- ◆ Helps to prevent contracture (lack of range of motion)

Continuous passive motion (CPM) devices are used during the first phase of rehabilitation following a soft tissue surgical procedure or trauma.
